Based on

ATTENTION: it is forbidden for foreign nationals to enter and stay in the territory of the Czech Rep. for reasons other than: travel to work and business or other similar activities, provision of care for children, relatives or animals, essential travel to health and social facilities services and trips to deal with urgent official or emergency matters, including the provision of necessary escorts of relatives and close relatives, attendance of funerals, travels to participate in education, including internships and examinations, participation in authorized gatherings, trips to one's place of residence (see Ref. No. MZDR 20599/2020-69/MIN/KAN).
