**\*\*Citizens of the Czech Republic, EU and citizen of the third countries** with permitted long-term or permanent residence in the European Union, are allowed to meet the requirement of submitting themselves, at their own expense, to an RT-PCR test for the presence of SARS CoV-2, by presenting a negative result of RT-PCR test for the presence of SARS CoV-2, which has been performed in the territory of the EU member state and which is not older than 72 hours; the test result is submitted immediately on entry into the territory of the Czech Republic to a regional Public Health Office.

The reply may be used as one of the supporting documents (not as an official confirmation) when entering the Czech Republic.
